# How to get to the campus

## Camperdown and Darlington campuses (main campus)

Most Sydney Uni *Live* activities will take place on the University of Sydney's Camperdown Campus, and the adjacent Darlington Campus (for other campus activities, see page opposite).

The campuses are located between Parramatta Road and Abercrombie Street, and separated by City Road. They are serviced by most major transport routes.

On the day a free shuttle bus will run between Central railway station and the Camperdown Campus (see details, right), while the Darlington Campus is a short (5 to 10 minute) walk from Redfern railway station.

## Parking

Limited free spaces will be available on the Camperdown and Darlington campuses (please comply with all relevant parking signs to avoid receiving a ticket).



## Free bus services

See map on page 16 for bus stops. Buses run **to and from** the following locations:

### Central (Railway Square) to the Quadrangle

Buses will run at 10-minute intervals between 9am and 4.30pm from Fisher Library.

### Shepherd Street car park to the Quadrangle

Buses will run at 15-minute intervals between 9am and 4.30pm from the corner of Manning and Fisher roads.

### Camperdown Campus to Macquarie Street (Sydney Conservatorium of Music)

Departs every 30 minutes between 9.30am and 3.30pm from the corner of Manning and Fisher roads.

### Camperdown Campus to Mallett Street Campus (Faculty of Nursing and Midwifery)

Departs every hour between 10am and 3.45pm from the corner of Manning and Fisher roads.

### Camperdown Campus to Rozelle Campus (Sydney College of the Arts)

Departs every 30 minutes between 9.30am and 4pm from the corner of Manning and Fisher roads.

Shepherd Street car park, located behind the Seymour Centre off Cleveland Street, has free parking all day as well as a free shuttle bus to the Quadrangle.
