# Take a tour

## Main campus

Enjoy a 30-minute guided tour of the Camperdown Campus with a University student ambassador. Tours depart from the Clocktower information booth on the hour, from 10am to 2pm.

## Faculties

### Architecture and Design Computing

Take a tour of the fabulous facilities for Architecture and Design Computing students. Visit art workshops, audio and acoustics labs, the famous Tin Sheds Gallery, Sentient Room, Heliodon, and wind tunnel. The 30-minute tours run from 10am in the Wilkinson Building foyer.

### Sydney Law School

Join staff of the Sydney Law School for guided tours of the New Law Building, showcasing the unique architecture and state-of-the-art facilities. Highlights include the electronic Moot Court and Dispute Resolution Centre, Law Library and superb views showing the University's connection with the city of Sydney. Tours run every 30 minutes from 9.30am to 3.30pm from the New Law Building foyer.

### Pharmacy

Imagine yourself studying in the many laboratories and tutorial rooms you'll see. Tours depart from the Pharmacy Lecture Theatre, Science Road at 9.30am, 11am, 12 noon, 1pm and 3pm.



### Engineering and IT Chemical and Biomolecular Engineering

Tours depart all day from the PNR bridge.

See the first-year teaching laboratory, three-storey distillation column, crystalliser, and many other interesting demonstrations, plus make your own 'silly putty' and enjoy coffee and cake at 'Café Chem Eng'.

### Aeronautical Engineering

Tours depart at 10.30am and 2pm from the PNR foyer (following the 'Aeronautical engineering' mini-lectures).

Take a fascinating trip through our aeronautical engineering laboratories, where you will see the flight simulator, wind tunnels, unmanned aerial vehicles, and a prototype aircraft.

### Civil Engineering

Tours depart between 10.30am and 2pm from the Civil Engineering Building.

See steel and concrete breaking, experience our wave machine, and explore our wind engineering, fluids, structures and geomechanics laboratories.

### Mechanical and Mechatronic Engineering

Tours depart all day from the foyer of the Mechanical Engineering Building.

See one of our FSAE competition cars (more information on page 3) and explore the mechatronics, materials and manufacturing laboratories.

### Electrical and Information Engineering

Tours depart at 10.30am and 12.30pm from the PNR foyer.

### Information Technologies

Tours depart at 11.30am and 2pm from the PNR foyer (following the 'Computer science and information systems' mini-lectures).

## Accommodation

### Residential colleges

Visit one or several of the residential colleges on campus, meet current residents and inspect the facilities. Living in college can add another dimension to your University experience, offering academic support as well as a window into sporting, cultural and social pursuits.

Tour departs at 1pm from the Old Geology Lecture Theatre (at conclusion of mini-lecture).

### Sydney University Village

Check out the Sydney University Village stall in the Quadrangle, speak to students about what it can offer you and take one of the many tours running throughout the day.

## Museums

### Nicholson and Macleay museums

Tours depart from the foyer of the Nicholson Museum each hour on the hour, from 10am to 3pm. Handle genuine archaeological artefacts, speak to archaeology and history students, watch film screenings and listen to short talks throughout the day.

### Pathology Museum

Meet in the foyer of the Edward Ford Building, Fisher Road, and take a guided tour of the fascinating – and sometimes gruesome – Pathology Museum. The 40-minute tours run every hour from 10am to 2pm.
